School Accreditation Status:

The North Central Association (NCA) Commission on Accreditation and School Improvement accredits Webster Elementary School without warning.

Core Curriculum:

Webster is continuing to implement the SCoPE Curriculum (Oakland Schools). We use Making Meaning, Being a Writer and Every Day Math. In addition, Guided Reading Groups were added to the curriculum in grades 1, 2 and 3.

Parent Participation:

82% of Webster students' parents were involved in school activities in a meaningful way.

Staff:

100% of our teaching staff is considered "highly qualified" by the state.

AYP:

Webster School did not make Adequate Yearly Progress during the 2009-2010 school year as calculated by the Michigan Department of Education. All subgroups made AYP with the exception of one group in the area of Reading.

Grade:

The Michigan Department of Education assigned a composite grade of "B" to Webster for the 2009-2010 school year.

Retention Rate:

0% of our student population was retained during the 2009-2010 school year.
